

The Shrine Sacred Grounds: Vigils and Holy Hours throughout the vear are presently held in Flushing Meadows Park, Flushing NY Diocese of Brooklyn, Queens County: Relocated from Bayside in 1975. Processions are held on the June 18th Anniversary & the May Crowning May 20th. Our Lady requests us to wear white gloves for processions. Bring a chair and warm clothing for outdoor weather. All are invited & will receive a rosary, rose petal sacramental, a fresh rose and messages to Veronica from Heaven.

The Shrine: Open-air in the Park. Outdoors ~ Exedra monument at the site of the former Vatican Pavilion of the old 1964-65 World's Fair Grounds, Flushing Meadows-Corona Park, Flushing, Queens County, NY 11368 on Long Island, (Borough of New York City, Diocese of Brooklyn)

Exedra Monument

(éxedra) is a circular, grey, granite monument with 3 steps and a semicircle wall and a curved bench (Stoa- a Greek design for meditation by a Basilica)



It commemorates the Vatican's World's Fair Pavilion in 1964-65 which exhibited Michelangelo's Pieta (means pity). Also built was a replica of the Tomb of St Peter. Prior to the World's Fair in 1939, the ground was an ash dump (symbol

of penance - 'sackcloth and ashes'). Pope Paul VI went to the Vatican Pavilion during the Fair and blessed the site in 1965 after visiting the United Nations. NY was chosen in honor of the 300th Anniversary of New York Sept 8, 1664

The Shrine is on the Ave of Europe, off Perimeter Road north of the



Amphitheater Bridge and east of the NY State Pavilion's two circular observation towers. The Shrine is 150vds SE of the famous steel 50ft Steel Unisphere Globe, and 50 vards SE of the Queens Theatre just south their east parking lot and east adjacent to the skateboard park rink. There are large evergreen yew trees on the sides of the exedra. The Shrine relocated from Veronica's parish at

the old St. Robert Bellarmine's Roman Catholic Church in Bayside, NY where Our Lady requests a Basilica, to this temporary site in the Park in 1975 by the Court in Queens County from harassment from the neighbors.

DRESS CODE - Our Lady requests all pilgrims to dress modestly and respectfully for prayer on the Sacred Grounds. Wear outdoor, casual attire for seasonal weather conditions: Men with long pants and women to dress lady-like, wearing a skirt / dress over the knees and a head covering with a mantilla, beret, scarf, or hat, etc.. Please no shorts, sleeveless, or immodest, tight clothing. Our Lady's requests -- Mary-like and purity.


